The chapter currently has 20 active members and covers the areas of Warner Robins, Centerville, Bonaire, Kathleen Perry, Byron and Fort Valley Georgia. The WRAC meets the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at 104A Gunn Road in Centerville GA.

Scholarships/Awards: Warner Robins Area Chapter provides annual ASU Scholarship Awards to local students; Annual Houston Regional Science and Engineering Fair Awards; and annual or as needed – Need Based Scholarships. Individual members also provide direct financial contributions for ASU scholarships and for the ASU Inaugural Blue and Gold Scholarship Gala. During 2019 Warner Robins Area Chapter contributed to ASU One Band -One Sound Band Uniforms.

Student Recruitment: WRAC provides bi-annual distribution of ASU Open House Announcements to area High Schools; hosts annual Student Recognition Dinners, assists at college recruitment fairs and attends area high school honor's night programs. The chapter offers honorary chapter membership for graduating ASU area students, and annually hosts a Christmas Social for ASU students from the local area and their parents.
